- Angel – provides a receptive space for spiritual input into the game. An opportunity for you to listen to your Guardian Angel and the Group Angel.
- Appreciation – a communication square, symbolized by the smiling face. Landing here invites you to either acknowledge the gift of any pain you hold and release it, or express appreciation to one other player and yourself.
- Blessing – an opportunity for you to give Awareness tokens to all players to bring increased growth and understanding to the game. When you share awareness as a blessing, you truly serve.
- Depression – depression can be very painful. A major roadblock. Feeling miserable, cut-off, unhappy and down. Unable to connect with or express other, more joyful feelings. This square urges a look below the surface to what may be driving these feelings or a look back to a similar time.
- Free Will – you get to use your Free Will to make a choice about how you'd like to move forward in the game. You'll learn the consequences of your choice immediately by drawing a card from the Universal Feedback deck.
- Insight – may underline steps you may take or are taking to realize your goal or pinpoint a strength or truth you need to remember. Ultimately insights increase your awareness.
- Intuitive Flash – a highly creative square which invites spontaneous action. You'll get to exercise, then check the accuracy of your intuition, using the Intuitive Flash Coin located in the Source.
- Miracle – a gift of grace, and a wonderful chance to release pain, bless the earth and express your individual choices.
- Service – heart square and a time to serve another player or yourself and to deepen your heart connection.
- Setback – uncovers an obstacle or limitation to your growth, recognize or feel the pain it brings, and discover ways to clear it.
- Transformation – time to make a major shift or acknowledge a shift that's occurred. Release old patterns and move to the next level.
